Reference: Map, South Vietnam, 1:50,000; Series 17014

1. (C) Task Organization: No Change
2. (C) Present Situation: Elements of the 3d Bn, 2d Regt, 3d NVA Division, continue to conduct operations, in eastern B A 226. They are attempting to evade US Forces which have been on the attack for the past 24 hours. They operate using trails and known lines of communication, in the base area.
3. (C) Orders to Subordinate Units:
  - a. Co A -- Remains at FSB AUGUSTA. No change to present mission.
  - b. Co B -- Move by stealth to blocking position vic BR823700. Be prepared to interdict enemy movement from the east, south, west and north, by patrolling and ambush.
  - c. Co C -- Retain patrol base vic BR802700. RIF to the south and south west across the blue line. Continue offensive operations. Relocate patrol base if desired. Move into the south pocket of the valley. Use walking artillery fire during movement.
  - d. Co D -- Move by stealth to blocking posn vic BR798673. Establish patrol base. Be prepared to interdict enemy movement from the east, south, west and north, by patrolling and ambush.
  - e. Recon Plat: Move at first light to vic BR830703. Perform RIF mission along Blue Line running to the south east. Be prepared to revert to recon reaction force mission in Bn AO.
  - f. Coy Mort Plat: GS
  - g. 3/4/12: BS
4. (C) Priority of fires to Unit in Contact.
5. (C) Coordinating Instructions:
  - a. As a minimum each company will employ ten (10) mechanical ambushes.
  - b. All units prepare to revert to search missions in assigned AO's.
  - c. DISMOUNT for cadres with cadres of adjacent units.
  - d. Units supplied on 4 day cycle normally.
  - e. Bn MC CP remains in present location.
  - f. Bn main CP remains at FSB AUGUSTA.
