2. Intelligence.

During the latter part of Oct until the present time there has been a marked increase of enemy activity within the AO. There have been numerous sightings, movements and indications of enemy presence through freshly used trails, hootches, waves, fresh cultivation, etc. B, C, & D companies plus the Recon Plat have had separate contacts with various size enemy elements during this period. Intelligence gathered locally and from higher indicates the enemy is trying to relocate major elements that effect the 1/12 Inf AO. Current intel reports indicate relocation will be to the south. Weather: The weather for the next several days will be effected by the fall monsoon with scattered rain showers and considerable cloud cover. Winds should remain variable at 5 to 10 knots.

Light Data: The moon is in the last quarter. Percent of illumination will decrease from 34% on the night of the 4th to 0% on the night of 10 Nov.
