SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 171 for 230001H to 232400H Apr 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf remains OPCON to the 4th Inf Div, operating from CAMP RADCLIFF.

(1) Co A performs as guard duty company.

(2) Co B operates in vic 577527 and returns to An Khe for stand down at 1435H.

(3) Co C remains OPCON to the 1/10th Cav, vic 141512.

(4) Co D performs search and destroy opn, vic BR573494 located 20 bunkers, 2x7x4' w/ 1' O/H; at least 1 year old, in front of the bunkers were located open fighters 3x5x3' neg recent use. Closed on Camp RADCLIFF by convoy at 1436H and assumed stand down posture.

(5) Recon conducted RIF and ambush opn vic BR555492. Returned to RADCLIFF to assume stand down posture.

B. Cumulative results of all opns since 15 Feb:

US losses: 33 WIA; 4 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 15 enemy KIA (BC); 9 S/A CIA; 3 radios, 4 switch boards, 4 field phones CIA; 76,220 lbs rice CIA.
