SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 173 for 250001H Apr to 252400H Apr 1970.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12 Inf remains OPCON to the 4th Inf Div moving vic BR456601 along Hwy 508 to build a fire base and secure D Co, 4th Eng, during repair and construction of road.

(1) Co A departs An Khe by convoy for new FSB. After arrival at FSB, 456601 begins clearing area, 3 EM's injured by punji stakes while clearing area.

(2) Co B remains at CAMP RADCLIFF for Golf Course pad security.

(3) Co C OPCON 1/10 Cav.

(4) Co D departs CAMP RADCLIFF in convoy with A Co for new FSB. Mission is to provide security, RIF and ambush. 81mm remain at FSB for support.

(5) Recon plat SP's CAMP RADCLIFF conducting RIF and ambushes in assigned AO.

B. Cumulative results of all opns since 15 Feb 70:

US losses: 36 WIA; 4 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA

US inflicted enemy losses: 15 enemy KIA, (BC); 4 switchboards, 4 field phones, 3 radios CIA; 76,220 lbs rice CIA.
