Situation Report #251

Period Covered: 130001 - 132400 July 70

Reference: Maps RVN, 1:50:000; Sheets 6637II, 6737III, 6737IV, 6637III.

1. Enemy: Elements of C2 407 Sapper Bn cont to operate in small 3-5 man teams and cont to maintain surveillance of friendly units in AO ODIN.

2. OWN SITUATION:

a. Forward elements are mobile in AO. 1-12 Inf (TF NAVAJO) cont on PUTNAM PARAGON with Bn CP located at FSB UTE, (BR356708).

b. Description and results of operations:

(1) Co A conducted S&C opns with neg significant results.

(2) Co B cont construction, security, and training at FSB UTE. Conducts local sweeps with neg findings.

(3) Co C cont construction, security and training at FSB ARMAGEDDON, BR419648.

(4) Co D conducting S&C mission in assigned AO had the following results: 3/D vic 348607 found a bamboo fence, 3' high and still under construction. Also found a trail 2' wide, visible from the air, which had been used in the last week by an undetermined number of individuals. 1/D vic 360609 found one Ho Chi Minh sandal print, 3 days old, heading south. At same location found a hootch 6x7x7' 3' off ground, last used by 6-7 indiv 1 month ago. 3/D vic 358608 received 20 - 30 rds A/W fire from 2 indiv. Returned fire and swept the area with neg finding 100m to the west found a hootch 6x7x5', 1 yr old. Last used by 3 indiv. Returned S/A and swept area with neg findings.

(5) Rcn remained on Hill 612 reporting neg significant findings.

3. Administration: TF NAVAJO cont to resupplied from Trains area at FSB ARMAGEDDON.
