1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12 cont opn PUTNAM PARAGON from FSB CHEYENNE, BR102731.

(1) A Co cont working in area bounded by 060735-100735_060750-100750. 2/A vic 073755 found an E-W oriented trail 24" wide and not visible from the air.

(2) B Co cont FSB security and construction

(3) C Co maintains blocking position and amb opns in same area of interest.

(4) D Co cont S&D opns working S in area: 1180-1380-1182-1382, w/ neg findings.

(5) Recon con RIF opn with neg significant findings.

US losses: 50 WIA; 15 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 22 enemy KIA, (BC); 3 VMC CIA; 24 S/A CIA; 16 satchel charges CIA; 2 Chicom radios, 1 PRC-10 CIA; 4 Chicom switchboards and 4 Chicom field phones CIA; 150,800 lbs rice and 1100 lbs salt CIA; miscellaneous documents and equipment CIA.
