SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 224 for 160001H to 160400H Jun 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf began a battalion move to establish a new fire base vic BR355708.

(1) A Co OPCON 2/35th, cont clearing of hook LZ and established a perimeter, for the new FSB, vic BR355708.

(2) B Co cont securing FSB CHEYENNE and prepares to move.

(3) C Co conducts CA from PZ vic 112765 to LZ vic 376676. One slick crashed in C Co's LZ with neg casualties. C Co cont the CA, leaving 1/C to secured the damaged bird. C Co(-) began S&D opns in the new AO bounded by 360660, 360680, 380660, 380680.

(4) D Co conducted a CA from PZ vic 123811 to an LZ located vic 355709 and moved into their primary area of interest bounded by 330710, 330730, 350710, 350730.

(5) Recon conducted CA from LZ CHEYENNE to a LZ vic 355708 and began moving N, primary area of interest 350710, 350730, 360710, 360730.

B. Cumulative results of all opns since 15 Feb.

US losses: 50 WIA; 15 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy loses: 22 enemy KIA, (BC); 3 VMC CIA; 24 S/A CIA; 16 satchel charges CIA; 150,800 lbs rice and 1100 lbs salt CIA; misc docu and equip CIA.
