SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 238 for 300001H Jun to 302400H Jun 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Infcont opn PUTNAM PARAGON from FSB ARMAGEDDON, 421646.

(1) A Co cont to maintain security of LZ EMELLIA and of Eng working on Route 508.

(2) B Co cont mission of securing and clearing FSB UTE.

(3) C Co cont S&A opns in same area vic 372602 sighted one indiv 10m to the WSW and engaged him. Indiv was wearing a green T-shirt, had long hair. The VMC carried an SKS. A blood trail was followed to the NW w/ neg findings. The indiv approached from the NE on a NE-SW trail. C Co vic 373604 found a small village consisting of 3 hootches, (6x8x4' and flat on the ground), 1 bunker (4x8x4' w/ 3' O/H), open on 2 sides) and 2 chicken coops. Area used in the last 48 hrs by 3-4 indiv.

(4) D Co cont ARMAGEDDON security and Eng security.

(5) Recon cont security of Hill 612, radio relay. Neg significant contacts.

B. Cumulative results of all elements since 15 Feb:

US losses: 54 WIA; 15 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA

US inflicted enemy losses: 27 enemy KIA, (BC); 9 VMC CIA; 28 S/CIA;
16 satchel charges CIA; 3 radios, 4 switchboards, 4 field phones CIA;
150,800 lbs rice, 1100 lbs salt CIA; misc docu and equip CIA.

2. Remarks: MG Walker visited 1/12th Inf at FSB ARMAGEDDON.
