SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 186 for 080001H May to 082400H May 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf concludes Bn CA into CAMBODIA, and begins sweeping area around the FSB.

(1) Co A SP'd the FSB moving east on a search and destroy mission finding the following.

(2) B Co SP'd he FSB moving to the NW. Vic 595445 they found 1 hootch. IN the vic of 594448 they found 6 hootches and 150 lbs of corn.

(3) C Co left the FSB moving to he NNW, finding 2 hootches; 4 sweatshirts; and 2 cutting knives.

(4) D Co was airlifted from LZ OASIS to FSB by Chinook and took over FSB security.

(5) Recon moved by air from LZ OASIS to he FSB, and moving north on a screening mission. Recon found vic 605455: 12 hootches; 5 sets fatigues, 2 green, 3 tiger; 2 sets web gear, 2 amo pouches; US belt; NVA shoes; 50 pigs; 200 chickens; and 1 chicom grenade.

B. Cumulative results of all ops since 15 Feb:

US losses: 37 WAA; 8 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 15 enemy KIA, (BC); 10 S/A CIA; 4 Chicom switchboards, 4 Chicom field phones, 2 Chicom radios, 1 PRC-10 CIA; 106,400 lbs rice CIA; miscellaneous documents and equipment CIA.
