SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 191 for 130001H May to 132400H May 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf conducts search and destroy opns in assigned AO from FSB COMMANCHE under the operational control of the 1st Bde.

(1) Co A was to become OPCON to the 3/506th but remained with the 1/12th in the assigned AO.

(2) Co B remained in the AO with the mission of working their way into the SEL from which they received fire 12 May. Vic YA455644 found 1 indiv KIA by 3/B from the contact of 12 May 70. Indiv was wearing green fatigues, web gear, neg headgear, unit insignia or weapon. B Co also located Sgt Sherry, MIA from 12 May contact, KIA.

(3) C Co received resupply vic 451611. Vic 464612 found 20 hootches, 15x25x6', with a bunker, 4x8x6' w/ 2' O/H; found 1 radio (Sony); last use 6 months ago by company size element.

(4) D Co remained at FSB for security.

(5) Recon cont their screening mission in assigned AO.

B. Cumulative results of all opns since 15 Feb 70:

US losses: 41 WIA; 13 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 18 enemy KIA, (BC); 19 S/A CIA; 4 switchboards, 4 field phones, 3 raidos CIA; 128,615 lbs rice CIA; miss docu and equip CIA.

2. Remarks: Because 1st Bde had only 1 slick and 1 Chinook to allocate to the CA of A Co, the opn was postponed. Two WIA's from 12 May contact extracted.
