SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 203 for 250001H May to 252400H May 1970.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf cont S&D opns, working out of FSB KIOWA, BR337657.

(1) A Co cont to work assigned AO, with neg significant sightings or contacts.

(2) Co B, vic 336636 had an accidental firing of an M-60 MG which resulted in 1 US WIA. Sgt Delp was hit in the upper left buttock. 2/B vic 334517 found a fallen hootch, 6x8x4', 6 mo old, had neg recent use. A khaki shirt and wire clips were found in the hootch. A fenced in tree was in the area which is believed to be an animal trap.

(3) C Co cont the mission of FSB security with sweeps and ambushes.

(4) D Co vic 397647 found an overnight location used by 15 indiv. There were 4 hootch poles erected for poncho hootches. Fresh cuttings in the area were also evidence the area had been used in the last 24H. Also found were: 2 lbs explosives powder in a sandbag; portion of a bangalore; can packed with powder, believed to be intended as a booby trap.

(5) Recon closed on KIOWA for resupply.

B. Cumulative results of all opns since 15 Feb:

US losses: 48 WIA; 15 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA

US inflicted enemy losses: 19 enemy KIA, (BC); 20 S/A CIA; 4 switchboards, 4 field phones; 3 radios CIA; 131,200 lbs rice CIA; miss docu and equip CIA.
