SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 155 for 070001H Apr to 072400H Apr 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12 Inf remains OPCON to the 4th Inf Div at CAMP RADCLIFF.

(1) A Co cont with care and cleaning of equip after returning from securing the 4th Aviation area.

(2) B Co cont with the care and cleaning of equip.

(3) C Co conducts a CA from CAMP RADCLIFF to an LZ vic 493638. A secondary explosion occurred vic grid 497651, NE of the LZ, while R/L was preping the area. C Co in exploiting the cache found by R-18, (LRRP), at 493637 uncovered 24 - 82mm rounds; 9 - 60mm rounds; 9 fuses and 3 cans of machine gun links. 2/C vic 494638 found a second cache containing 6 - 82mm rds; 35 - 81mm rds of foreign make; 3 - 57mm RR rds; 9 - B40 rds and 5 charges. 1 - B 41

(4) D Co remains OPCON 1/10 Cav.

(5) Recon cont maintenance and cleaning of equip.
