1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12 Inf remains OPCON to 4th Inf Div, operating from CAMP RADCLIFF.

(1) Company A serves as ready reaction force and training. At 1530 hours DTOC alerted the 3rd plat Co A to CA to BR514642. 3/A reported 2 EM with punji wounds vic 514642, to be extracted 12 Apr. At 0940H Bn alerted by DTOC for mission, (RIF) into area bounded by 360440, 360400, 400440, 400400. Operation to begin at first light on 12 Apr.

(2) B Co OPCON to 2/35, deployed on RIF at grid 534932.

(3) C Co serves as guard co for CAMP RADCLIFF.

(4) D Co conducted training at CAMP RADCLIFF.

(5) Recon to conduct CA with A Co on 12 Apr at first light.

(6) 8.2" mortar conducted training.

B. Cumulative results of opns since 15 Feb 70.

US losses 33 WIA; 4 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 15 enemy KIA, (BC); 9 S/A CIA; 3 radios, 4 field phones, 4 switchboards CIA; 76,220 lbs rice CIA.
