SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 160 for 120001H Apr to 122400H Apr 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12 Inf remains OPCON to the 4th Inf Div, operating from Camp Radcliff.

(1) A Co conducts CA from Camp Radcliff to an LZ vic BR390423 and conducts RIF, lasting approx 2 days. A Co(\*) found 500 ears of corn in brush vic 386431; approx 2 mo old with neg recent use. 2/A found an 18" wide trail not visible from the air and a basket covered with a tarp which contained 15 ears of corn; both were 4-6 months old with neg recent use.

(2) B Co remains OPCON 2/35.

(3) C Co conducts security of the Golf Course Pad and participates in 1/2 day training.

(4) Recon conducts a CA from Camp Radcliff to an LZ vic BR363403 to constitute an ambush blocking force.

(5) D Co continues training and maintains reaction readiness.

(6) 4.2" mortars cont with maintenance and training.

(7) Effective 1345H all current operations were terminated, A Co and Recon move to QL-19 for immediate extraction, 1/12 Inf reverts to 2d Bde Control and move on order overland to vic Pleiku. Mission cancelled 1720H, 1/12 Inf OPCON to 4th Inf Div, effective 1800H, Recon OPCON 1/10 Cav.

B. Cumulative results of opns since 15 Feb:

US losses: 33 WIA; 4 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1KCS WIA.
