## 1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12 Inf remains OPCON to the 4th Inf Div operating out of FSB AQUARIUS, providing security for D- 4th Engineers.

(1) Co A provides fire base security; mission of securing the engineers on mine sweeps, recon and the building of the bunker line.

(2) Co B remains at CAMP RADCLIFF for Golf Course Pad security.

(3) C Co remains OPCON to 1/10 Cav.

(4) Recon conducts RIF and ambush operations in assigned AO. One EM dusted off as result of punji stake wound. Neg significant sightings or contacts.

(5) D Co conducts RIF and ambush opns in assigned AO. Reports neg significant sightings or contacts.

## B. Cumulative results of all opns since 15 Feb. 70:

US Losses: 37 WIA; 4 KIA.

Fdly Losses: 1 KCSWIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 15 enemy KIA (BC); 9 S/A CIA; 4 switchboards, 4 field phones, 3 radios CIA; 76,220 lbs rice CIA.
