1.(C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12 Inf remains OPCON to the 4th Inf Div, operating from FSB AQUARIUS, providing security for D-4th Engineers.

(1) Co A provides FSB and road security for engineers.

(2) Co B remains at CAMP RADCLIFF performing Golf Course security and on stand-by as reaction element for 4th Inf Div.

(3) Co C OPCON 1/10 Cav.

(4) Co D conducts RIF and ambush operations in area bounded by grids 4263, 4463, 4461, 4261. Reports neg significant findings.

(5) Recon conducts RIF and ambush opns in area bounded by 4563, 473630, 473620, 4562. Vic 468617 Recon plat found 4 hootches, (3x5x3'), with approx 5400 lbs of rice; used within the last 2 months by an unknown number of indiv.

B. Cumulative results of all opns since 15 Feb 70:

US losses: 36 WIA; 4 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 15 enemy KIA(BC); 9 S/A CIA; 4 field phones, 4 switchboards and 3 radios CIA; 81,620 lbs rice CIA.
