SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 176 for 282000H Apr to 282400H Apr 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12 Inf remains OPCON to the 4th Inf Div, operating out of FSB AQUARIUS, providing security for D-4th Engineers.

(1) Co A remains at FSB providing security for FSB and D-4th Engineers.

(2) Co B remains at CAMP RADCLIFF on Golf Course security mission.

(3) Co C OPCON 1/10 Cav.

(4) Co D maintains ambushes and conducts RIF in area bounded by 459600, 448640, 410641, 417597. 2/D vic 442614 located a trail 6-8" wide running N-S, and visible from the air.

(5) Recon with 2/A attached, vic 468619 received 1 B40 and 30-40 rds S/A fire, resulting in 1 US WIA. 4.2" and E/L employed. Neg results. V,c 468619 Recon found 3 hootches, 3x5x3' approx 2 mo old with 4950 lbs of husked rice.

B Cumulative results of all opns since 15 Feb 70:

US losses: 37 WIA; 4 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 15 enemy KIA(BC); 9 S/A CIA; 4 switchboards, 4 field phones, 3 radios CIA; 86,600 lbs rice CIA.
