1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 12th Inf cont opn PUTNAM PARAGON from FSB UTE, BR356708.

(1) Co A cont S&C mission, conducting small unit ambushes in AO bounded by 390715, 420715, 390745, 420745. 3/A vic 421720, found 3 hootches, very old fallen in. Approx size 8x7x10'. Could not determine last use or age of structures.

(2) Co B cont construction and security of FSB UTE, with local Amb and RIF opns.

(3) Co C conducted CA of 1st plat to FSB ARMAGEDDON, to assume the mission of securing the Engineers working on QL 508. The remaining 2 plat cont S&C opns in AO bounded by 365600, 405600, 365620, 405620. Reported neg significant findings.

(4) Co D conducted CA of 1 plat from ARMAGEDDON to LZ vic 382608. The 2 remaining plat cont security of ARMAGEDDON and the Engineer effort on QL 508.

(5) Recon cont to provide security for 81c(-) and radio relay on Hll 612, 399636 and conducted local RIF's and amb.

B. Cumulative results of all opns since 15 Feb:

US losses: 54 WIA; 15 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA

US inflicted enemy losses: 27 enemy KIA, (BC); 9 VMC CIA; 28 S/A CIA; 16 satchel charges CIA; 2 Chicom radios, 1 PRC-10, 4 Chicom field phones, 4 Chicom switchboards CIA; 150,800 lbs rice and 1100 lbs salt CIA, misc docu and equip CIA.
