Situation Report #248

Period Covered: 100001 - 102400 July 1970

Reference: Map RVN, 1:50,000, Sheets 6637II, 6737III, 6737IV, 6637III.

1. Enemy: Elements of C2 407 Sapper Bn cont to operate in small 3-5 man teams and continue to maintain surveillance of friendly units in AO ODIN.

2. Own Situation:

a. Forward elements are mobile in AO. 1-12 Inf (TF NAVAJO) continued opn PUTNAM PARAGON with Bn CP located at FSB UTE, (BR356708).

b. Description of and results of operations:

(1) Co A operating out of a temporary PB vic 399750, conducted special mission to suspected wpns cache vic 437740 with the aid of a VMC, also a T-40 station vic 367740. The search was conducted with neg findings. A vic 367740 found a hole 6x4x6' and a trail running NE-SW, neg recent use.

(2) Co B cont construction security and training mission at FSB UTE, (BR356708), conducting local RIF's.

(3) Co C cont construction, security and training mission at FSB ARMAGEDDON, (BR419648).

(4) Co D cont S&D and amb ops in AO bounded by 340600, 370600, 340630 370630. D Co vic 355612 received 8 rds SKS fire from the SE 200m. A sweep of the area had neg findings. At the same location at 1550 hrs they received 7-8 60mm mortar rds from the SE. Rds landed 150m to the NNE and there were neg friendly casualties.

(5) Recon cont security of 81c(-) and the relay station on Hill 612, BR399636, conducting local RIF's and ambushes. Vic 398629 found trail of broken brush, running on AZ340°, last used 7-14 days ago

3. Administration: TF NAVAJO cont to be resupplied from Trains area at FSB ARMAGEDDON (BR419648).
