SUBJECT: Daily SIHEP 225 for 170001H to 172400H Jun 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf completes battalion move and establishes FSB TUSCARORA, BR355708, as a part of opn PUTNAM PARAGON.

(1) A Co cont clearing and construction of new FSB providing LZ security.

(2) B Co conducts CA from LZ CHEYENNE to LZ vic 392706, and begins working in area bounded by 390690, 410690, 390710, 410710.

(3) 1/C conducts CA from 112765 to LZ at ~~376676~~ to join the rest of C Co working in area 360660, 360680, 380660, 380680. 3/C vic 365670 found a hootch 12x6x7' 2' off the ground, 9-12 mo old and of neg recent use. A N-S trail, 12" wide and not visible from the air was located in this area also. The trail was last used 2 mo ago by an undetermined number.

(4) D Co cont working in area of primary interest; finding a trail vic 347111. The trail was oriented N-S, 8-10' wide and visible from the air. The trail is indicated on the map. Neg recent use.

(5) Recon cont RIF opns in area of interest locating a bunker vic 355700. Bunker was 4x3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' and had 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' O/H, was 8 mo old and had neg recent use. A SW-NE trail in the area 12" wide was last used by 3-4 indiv 1 mo ago.

B. Cumulative results of all opns since 15 Feb:

US losses: 50 WIA; 15 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA

US inflicted enemy losses: 22 enemy KIA (BC); 3 VMG CIA; 24 S/A CIA; 16 satchel charges CIA; 3 radios, 4 field phones and 4 switchboards CIA; 150,800 lbs rice and 1100 lbs salt CIA; misc docu and equip CIA.
