(3) C Co conducts S&D mission in area defined by 3563-3561-3861-3863.

(4) D Co cont to secure EMELLIA, and the Eng working on the road.

(5) Recon cont to maintain security of radio relay and 81mm hipshot on Hill

12, sending out s-d size RIF's to the E and W.
