SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 235 for 270001H Jun to 272400H Jun 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf cont opn PUTNAM PARAGON from FSB ARMAGEDDON, BR 2646.

(1) A Co moves overland to LZ EMELLIA to replace D Co of road security mission.

(2) B Co cont to operate in area defined by 5165-5266-5363-5263. Vic 505633

the 3d plat located a 6-9 mo old hootch, 6x5x4', 2' off the ground, had neg recent use. Then moving north on a trail (12" wide, neg recent use) 100m found 2 hootches, 10x10x15', 2' off the ground. Vic 504631, 3/B found a village (50x30m) made up of 12 hootches (5x10x6', 2' off the ground), and 9 bunkers (5x5x4' w/ 2' O/H). Each hootch had a vas of rice wine. Neg recent use of the area. There was a 12" wide trail going east from the village but had neg recent use. B Co vic 510649 located 3 fields, (200x100 and 50x100m) both had some type of potato root plant growing. Also a 10" trail, (SW-NE) and a sleeper large enough for 10, last used 2 weeks ago.

(3) C Co works in primary area of interest, 3561-3861-3859-3559. At 1830H vic 362602, received 20 rds AK fire from 50m to the SW. A RIF found 1 pair of sandel prints, indiv fled on a 300⁰ AZ.

(4) D Co moves to ARMAGEDDON by convoy and takes over FSB and Eng security.

(5) Rcn cont securing Raide relay and C Co 81mm on Hill 612, conducts RIF to S & W. At 405630 found dried up stream oriented E-W, used by 3 indiv in the past week going west. At 395619 found 8 fighters w/ out O/H. To the NW was an 8" trail of neg recent use.

grenades CIA (China), 150,000 lbs rice, 1100 lbs salt CIA; also down and enemy
CIA.
