SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 179 for 01000JH May to 012400H May 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12 Inf remains OPCON to the 4th Inf Div operating from FSB AQUARIUS; providing security for D-4th Engineers.

(1) Co A departs AQUARIUS by convoy to the north on Hwy 508. Dismount vic 420637 and move into AO bounded by 420660, 440660, 420637, 440637. Conducts RIF and ambush opns in assigned area and employs sniper team vic 422645. Vic 425615 one of the engineer trucks in the convoy hit a mine with the right front tire. The convoy was proceeding N, and the mine was on the right side of the road going N. One EM, (SSG Potter of D-3thtEng) suffered lacerations of the face and legs. The right front wheel of the vehicle was blown off, as was the right front fender. The engine and body were also damaged. The crater formed by the blast was 4' in diameter, and 2½' deep.

(2) Co B remains at CAMP RADCLIFF as Golf Course security.

(3) C Co OPCON 1/10 Cav.

(4) D Co closes on the FSB and takes over security and construction of fire base from A Co.

(5) Recon conducts RIF and ambush opns in assigned AO.

US losses: 37 WIA; 4 KIA

Fdly losses: 1 KGS WIA.
