SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 185 for 070001H May to 072400H May 70.

1. (C) Operational Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf conducts CA from LZ OASIS to CAMBODIA

(1) Co A SP's LZ OASIS for CAMBODIA. One of the A Co slicks crashed vic YA7343; four members of A Co's 81mm mortar section were killed. Two birds were diverted to provide security for the downed helicopter. A Co provided security at FSB. During their initial sweep of the area, A Co received S/A fire from one individual wearing a yellow shirt, and carrying an AK-47. A Co returned fire, with neg casualties and neg results.

(2) Co B remained at LZ OASIS and prepared for the move to FSB on 8 May.

(3) C Co conducted CA to new FSB, and remained there for security.

(4) 3/D was airlifted from LZ OASIS to secure the wreckage of the aircraft that went down with A Co personnel. The remainder of D Co remained at LZ OASIS preparing to move 8 May.

(5) Recon remained at LZ OASIS, preparing to move on 8 May 70.

B. Cumulative results of all opns since 15 Feb:

US losses: 37 WIA; 4 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 15 enemy KIA(B); 9 S/A CIA; 4 switchboards, 4 field phones and 3 radios CIA; 88,600 lbs rice CIA.
