SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 193 for 150001H May to 152400H May 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf moves from FSB COMMANCHE, CAMBODIA, to NEW PLEI DJERENG, VIETNAM

(1) Co A OPCON to the 3/506th Abn Inf, conducted CA to NEW PLEI DJERENG, and chopped back to 1/12th Inf.

(2) Co B moved from vic YA447633 to a PZ vic FSB COMMANCHE, and was airlifted by Chinook to Trains area.

(3) C Co airlifted by Chinook to Trains area.

(4) D Co airlifted out of COMMANCHE by Chinook and Huey to Trains area.

(5) Recon airlifted to Trains area.

B. Cumulative results of all opns since 15 Feb:

US Losses: 47 KIA, 15 KIA.

Fdly Losses: 1 KCS WIA

US inflicted enemy losses: 18 enemy KIA, (BC); 19 S/A CIA; 4 switchboards, 4 field phones, 3 raidos CIA; 128.615 lbs rice CIA; miss docu and equip CIA.

2. Remrks: Air Assets from 1st Bde were very poor, unable to get a C&C ship for the Bn CO until the very last moment; unable to get verification as to the birds available from 1st Bde; slicks came one at a time, with approx 30 min between birds, resulted in piecemeal extraction; neg G/S for final extraction poor coordination between Pathfinders and slicks as to where they would land.
