SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 204 for 260001H May to 262400H May 70.

1. (c) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf cont its S&D ops out of FSB KIOWA, BR337657.

(1) A Co moved to the SW in their assigned AO. 3/A vic 308608 sighted 3 unkn indiv in the open vic 300603. R/L employed.

(2) 3/B vic 342630 found a sleeper-type hootch 40x10x8', 2-3 mo old, last use 2-3 mo ago by an undetermined number. Vic 343631 3/B found a rice hootch 6x5x4' w/ 100 lbs unpolished rice; 3 mo old, neg recent use. 1/B vic 337634 found 2 hootches 8x6x6', 6-8 mo old, last use 3 weeks ago, by 2 indiv. B Co vic 342633 reported a Chinook at 337644 received approx 20 rds AK fire. Flipper 44 (Chinook) reported the same thing. 4.2" mortars employed. 2/B vic 340616 found 6 fighters, 2x3x4' approx 2 mo old, neg recent use.

(3) C Co remained as FSB security.

(4) D Co cont working in assigned AO with neg significant findings.

(5) Recon moved out of KIOWA to cont screening mission. Vic 358658 found 3 hootches and a bunker. 1 hootch 15x8x8' large enough for 15 indiv. 1 hootch was 6x6x6', a sleeper. The 3rd hootch was 4x4x6', cage type containing 2 baskets. The bunker was 6x10x5' O/H varied from 8" to 2'. A US 5 gal gas can found, also a handbook of judo and karete in English.

B. Cumulative results of all ops since 15 Feb:

US losses: 48 WIA; 15 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 19 enemy KIA; 20 S/A CIA; 4 switchboards, 4 field phones, 3 radios CIA; 131,300 lbs rice CIA; miss dmcu and equip CIA.
